This is the meeting promoted for the last two months...your chance to practice netting, inspecting, and bagging koi. You will also be able to scrape and scope It will be good practice for the first emergency in your pond, when you have to catch and isolate a fish for transport, treatment, or for photographing. Note the morning meeting time — 9:00 AM, as decided by a vote at Mac McClain's house.

This opportunity is presented because Theo needs to cull his koi: after a few spawns in recent years, the fish load is becoming too heavy for the size of the pond. The koi being pulled will be moved to a show tank or bagged, ready to be rehomed. If you've checked your own fish load and are interested in adding any new fish, you might spot one here that you like; they will be available for purchase for a \$25 donation to IKS. Make sure you are prepared to quarantine if you do buy a fish. That said, know that Theo's pond is "clean," with no new koi in years (except for the spawns), no parasites and no diseases.

This will not be a potluck meeting; there will be coffee and doughnut for all. The Zoetemelks' is one of the easiest addresses to find. Taking the 15 north from the 91, you exit right (east) on Second Street, go barely two blocks and watch for the Dutch windmill on your left. Turn left into the driveway and park at the top — we'll all be there.

Those who volunteered to help with the set-up on Saturday will meet at 10 am; the layout will be similar to that for an auction, another good learning opportunity for those who haven't worked one of our auctions.
